At the Annual Meeting, members will be given an opportunity to sign up for committee membership. An overview of the committees that are proposed for creation by the membership is provided below:

**Membership Committee.** *The membership committee shall, in coordination with the Board:*

- *conduct an annual membership recruitment in March*
- *help plan the April annual meeting*
- *help organize an annual membership event such as the Women's Equality Day cocktail party*

**Publicity Committee.** *The publicity committee shall, in coordination with the Board:*

- *draft press releases and plan media strategies*
- *maintain the website*
- *establish and maintain a Facebook and/or other social network pages*

**Events Committee.** *The events committee shall, in coordination with the Board, plan all major events such as the:*

- *Women's History Month scholarship program*
- *Women's Equality Day anniversary celebration*
- *Elizabeth Cady Stanton birthday celebration*

**Community Service Committee.** *The community service committee shall, in coordination with the Board, organize community service projects and activities such as:*

- *Eileen and Elizabeth's closet*
- *donations, such as gift baskets, for other organizations*
- *participation in other events such as the ECS Women's Consortium symposium*

**Education and outreach committee.** *The education and outreach committee shall, in coordination with the Board, develop collaborative working relationships with others who want to learn more about the life and time of ECS. The committee may:*

- *prepare a local school program*
- *authorize a speaker's bureau*

- *prepare local history displays*

**Tours and Trails committee.** *The tours and trails committee shall, in coordination with the Board:*
